



“BOO” Greeting Card

Materials:

- [Inkadinkado®](#) Creepy Crawly Clear Stamps
- [Tsukinelo®](#) Staz-On® Ink: Pumpkin, Black
- [Tsukinelo®](#) Sponge Dauber
- Beacon® Zip Dry
- Other supplies: Acrylic block for stamps, blue painter’s tape, fine sandpaper, paper towels, fine black pen, scissors, scrap of thin paper

Instructions:

Note: Items not listed above, but referred to in the instructions, are found inside the Mini Tool Set. Refer to color photos for application and placement.

1. Cut papers: stripe is 4 ½ x 6”, dot print is 4 ¼ x 3 ¾” and 2 3/8 x 1 ¾”.
2. Place Sponge Dauber on finger. Use with Pumpkin Ink to add color to edges of decorative papers and card.
3. Attach spider web clear stamp on acrylic block. Use Black Ink to stamp image on backside of Metal.
4. Use pen to write “BOO” on thin paper. Tape back side of paper with word on square of Metal. Be sure you can see the reversed word. Place Metal on top of foam mat.
5. To emboss both the spider web image and “BOO” word, attach the Metal Detailer Point and Nylon Universal Point onto the Handle. With the metal pieces on the foam mat, use the Metal Detailer to trace over stamp image and word. To refine both the embossed spider web and word, flip the Metal over and place on a hard surface. Use the Nylon Detailer to refine around the embossed lines. Use both Points to refine and define the image until the desired effect is achieved.
6. Cut the Metal: spider web is 3 ¾ x 3”, BOO is 2 x 1 ½”.
7. Attach the Medium Roller onto the Handle. Roll on edges of backside of Metal.
8. Use Sponge Daubers on finger to add ink to the front side of the Metal: Pumpkin on “BOO” and Black on spider web. Let dry.
9. Use sandpaper to lightly sand Inks off embossed words and Roller borders to reveal metal.
10. To adhere embossed Metal to the card, use Metal Tape. Cut Tape into pieces that are the same length as each edge of Metal. Affix Tape to back of Metal. Remove backing from Tape. Press Metal in place onto the dot print papers.
11. Use Zip Dry to adhere the papers in place on card front.
