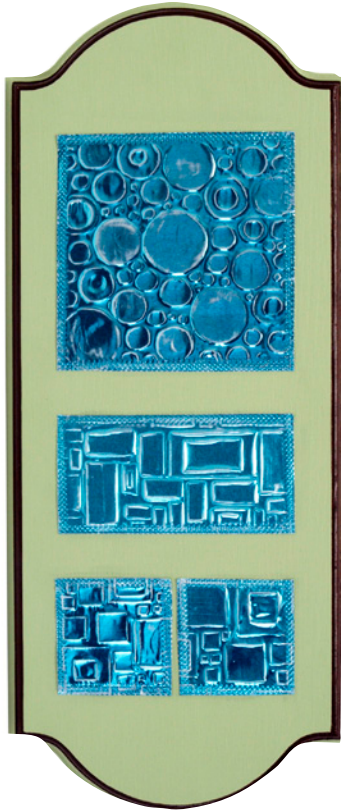


Circles, Rectangles & Squares, Oh My!

Materials:

- Other supplies: blue painter's tape, foam brush, paper towel, sandpaper

Instructions:

Note: Items used below, but not listed in supplies, are included in Beginner Set.

1. To prepare wood for painting, use sandpaper to lightly sand wood surface. Remove dust with paper towel.
2. Use foam brush to apply Green Tea acrylic paint to entire wood surface. Let dry and apply second coat if needed. Let dry.
3. Use Brown Pen, following manufacturer's directions, to accent Innkeeper Sign on decorative edges.
4. Use scissors to cut one Light Blue Metal Square in half. Cut one of the rectangles into 2 equal squares.
5. Use blue painter's tape to hold Metal pieces on top of each Design Square. Place a Metal Square on the Circle Design Square, a Metal Rectangle on the Rectangle Design Square, and the small Metal Squares on the Square Design Square. Using the Texture Tool, rub over the Metal to reveal the design images. Continue rubbing until the entire image is visible.
6. To refine the embossed images, attach the Nylon Detailer Point and Nylon Universal Point onto Handle. Use both Points to refine and define the images. The Metal can be turned back and forth, embossing and debossing the images until the desired effect is achieved.
7. Attach a Roller Point onto the Handle. Use the ruler to assist in rolling a decorative edge around each Metal piece.
8. Use sandpaper to lightly sand Metal to highlight design.
9. Use Metal Tape to adhere each piece of Metal to wood. Cut Metal Tape to fit back of each piece. Press in place. Remove backing and press onto wood surface.
