



# “Happy Halloween” Greeting Card

## Materials:

- [Walnut Hollow® #24422 Creative HotMarks™](#)
- [Walnut Hollow® 26310 HotStamps™ Everyday Series 1](#)
- [The Paper Company](#)
  - Card & Envelopes, 4 ½” x 6 ¼”
  - Color Connect Paper, Mandarin
- Inkadinkado® Creepy Crawly Clear Stamps
- [Tsukineko®](#) Staz-On® Ink: Pumpkin, Timber Brown
  - Sponge Dauber
- [Beacon®](#) Zip Dry
- Other supplies: Acrylic block for stamps, pliers, scissors, scrap paper

## Instructions:

*Note: Before using the Creative HotMarks™, read all instructions and follow all safety precautions. Use tape to secure stand to hard surface. Place Creative HotMarks™ on stand. Plug into electric outlet, press switch “ON”, and let heat 4 -5 minutes. When finished with your project, turn switch “off” and unplug.*

*Refer to color photos for application and placement*

1. Attach the Pumpkin HotStamp on the Tool using pliers.
2. Place front of card on top of 3-4 pieces of scrap paper. The paper under the card acts as a cushion to help create a better image when hot stamping. It is best to practice hot stamping a few times before you stamp onto your project. Hot stamp pumpkin border on card and envelope.
3. Cut patterned paper to 3 3/8 x 5”. Cut solid paper 2 ¾” x 1 ½”.
4. Attach “Happy Halloween” clear stamp to acrylic block. Use Timber Brown Ink to stamp image on solid paper.
5. Place Sponge Dauber on finger and use Pumpkin Ink to add color to all paper edges including envelope. Also add a little color over hot stamped pumpkins on envelope.
6. Use Zip Dry to adhere papers in place on card front.
