

# Home Décor Rectangle Clock

## Materials:

- [Basswood Rectangle Plaque #1826, Walnut Hollow®](#)
- [Clock Movement with Hands #TQ700P, Walnut Hollow®](#)
- [Metal Clock Face, Ivory Circle #27274, Walnut Hollow®](#)
- Brush, Large Flat
- Acrylic Paint to match Decorative Paper
- Electric Drill with 3/8" Drill Bit
- Other Supplies: AA battery, craft glue, decorative paper, paper towel, pencil, ruler, sandpaper, scissors, spray varnish

## Instructions:

1. Use sandpaper to lightly sand wood surface. Remove dust with paper towel.
2. Use ruler to locate center of plaque. Mark with pencil. Use electric drill with 3/8" drill bit to drill hole for clock movement.
3. Use large flat brush with acrylic paint to paint entire wood surface. Let dry and apply second coat if needed. Let dry.
4. Apply 2-3 coats of spray varnish for a protective finish.
5. Cut decorative paper to fit front of plaque. Lay plaque, top side down, on paper. Use pencil to trace around top of plaque. Use scissors to cut paper. Note: A template could be made with plain white paper and then traced onto the decorative paper and cut with scissors.
6. Use craft glue to adhere paper to plaque. Let dry. Use scissors to remove paper from clock movement opening.
7. Attach clock face to front of plaque. Press in place.
8. Attach clock movement following directions on packaging.
9. Insert AA battery.
