

Quilt Shelf



Materials:

- [Walnut Hollow® #26718 Homestead Quilt Shelf – 30"](#)
- [Walnut Hollow® #14300-14337 Wood Letters, Numbers and Punctuation](#)
- Paint
- Scraps of coordinating fabric
- Other Supplies: brush, fabric glue, paper towel, sandpaper, small scissors, wood sealer, spray varnish

Instructions:

1. To prepare wood for painting, apply wood sealer to entire surface. Let dry. Use sandpaper to lightly sand entire wood surface. Remove dust with paper towel.
2. Use brush to apply paint to shelf. Let dry. Lightly sand, apply second coat and let dry.
3. Apply 2-3 coats of spray varnish for a protective finish.
4. Use fabric glue to adhere different scraps of fabric to front of letters. Apply glue evenly to wooden letter and lay fabric on wood. Remove any wrinkles by smoothing with fingers. Let dry.
5. Use small scissors to remove excess fabric on letters. Trim right up to the edge of each letter for a neat appearance.
6. Center letters on front of shelf. Adhere with glue. Let dry.
7. Attach quilt to quilt shelf bar and slide into bracket openings.
