

“Trick or Treat” Greeting Card

Materials:

Card & Envelopes, 4 ½" x 6 ¼"
- [BasicGrey®](#), Ambrosia™ – 6 x 6" paper pad
- Inkadinkado® Creepy Crawly Clear Stamps
- [Tsukineko®](#) Staz-On® Ink: Timber Brown: Sponge Dauber
- [Ranger®](#) Adirondack® Alcohol Inks: Terra Cotta, Pitch Black; Blending Solution, Applicator
- [Beacon®](#) Zip Dry
- Other supplies: Acrylic block for stamps, blue painter's tape, fine sandpaper, paper towels, scissors, scrap of thin paper

Instructions:

Note: Items not listed above, but referred to in the instructions, are found inside the Mini Tool Set. Refer to color photos for application and placement.

1. Cut papers: red-orange is 4 ½ x 6", print is 4 x 5 ½", yellow-orange is 2 ½ x 2 ½".
2. Place Sponge Dauber on finger and use Timber Brown Ink to add color to edges of decorative papers.
3. Attach "Trick or Treat" clear stamp to acrylic block. Use Timber Brown Ink to stamp image onto scrap of thin paper.
4. Tape back side of paper with image on square of Metal. Make sure you can see the image. Place Metal on top of foam mat. Attach the Metal Detailer Point and Nylon Universal Point onto the Handle. Use the Metal Detailer to trace stamp image onto Metal. To refine the embossed words, flip the Metal over and place on a hard surface. Use the Nylon Detailer to refine the lines. Use both Points to refine and define the image until the desired effect is achieved.
5. Use Alcohol Inks and Blending Solution with Applicator to add color to front of Metal piece. Let dry. Use sandpaper to lightly sand Inks off embossed words
6. To adhere embossed Metal to the card, use Metal Tape. Cut Tape into pieces that are the same length as each edge of Metal. Affix Tape to back of Metal. Remove backing from Tape. Press Metal in place onto the yellow-orange paper.
7. Use Zip Dry to adhere the papers in place on card front.
