



# Woodburned Veranda Box

## Materials:

- [Walnut Hollow® #23906 Creative Versa-Tool™](#)
- Walnut Hollow® #27551 Veranda Box – Small
- [Walnut Hollow® #1095 Graphite Transfer Paper](#)
- Attached Heart Pattern
- Other Supplies: Brush-on or spray varnish, paper towel, pencil, pliers, sandpaper, tape

## Instructions:

1. To prepare wood for woodburning, use sandpaper to lightly sand wood surface. Remove dust with a paper towel.
2. Place heart pattern on center of box lid. Tape in place. Slide graphite paper, graphite side down, under pattern. Use pencil to trace pattern. When complete, remove pattern and graphite paper.
3. Before using Creative Versa-Tool™, read directions and follow all safety precautions. Attach Universal Point to tool. Tighten with pliers. Use tape to secure stand to hard surface. Place tool on stand. Plug into electric outlet, turn switch on, and let heat for 4-5 minutes. Practice on a piece of wood before beginning project.
4. Use Universal Point to burn the heart design. Do not press hard, let the tool do the work. Glide the point over the traced lines. When complete, shade inside the lines. Lay the flat side of the point on the wood and move in little circles until the shading is complete. Turn switch off and let cool.
5. Remove Universal Point from tool. Attach the Star Stamp to tool. Tighten with pliers. Follow directions for use as stated above.
6. Use Star Stamp to create a border around edge of box lid. Press Star Stamp onto wood and lift. Practice on a scrap of wood before stamping box to get a feel for how long to hold the stamp in place. When complete, turn switch off and unplug tool.
7. Apply 2-3 coats of either brush-on or spray varnish for a protective finish
